## Animal Health (Emergency Measures for Outbreaks of Infectious Diseases) Order 2022 Avian influenza

## Declaration of Elephant Bay, Pebble Island as free from Avian Influenza (article 6(2))

1. On 17 November 2023, I, Andrea Clausen, Director of Natural Resources, made a notice under article 5(4) as read with article 6(1) (declaration of infected place) of the Animal Health (Emergency Measures for Outbreaks of Infectious Diseases) Order 2022 (**"the Order"**) to Dorothy and Alexander Gould of Pebble Island ("**the Occupier**") declaring the sand beach known as Elephant Bay, Pebble Island as an infected place (**"the Infected Place**").

After having consulted with the Senior Veterinary Officer as is required under article
6(3) of the Order I am satisfied that-

- (a) infection or contamination of Avian Influenza is no longer present at the Infected Place; and
- (b) cleansing and disinfection has been completed in accordance with the requirements in the said notice.

3. I therefore declare that the notice of declaration of the Infected Place that 1 made on 17 November 2023 is hereby formally revoked in accordance with article 6(2) of the Order as from 01 December 2023.
